

Instructions

1. Rinse out any excess debris on the dial with fresh water then dry off the entire area.
2. Take the Dial Removal tool out and align it on the current dial. Suction is needed, so you should **use a little bit of soap and water** on the inside of the tool and align it just above the circle cutout so that it is flat against the dial.
3. Push the removal tool down until you feel like you have a good grip on the dial (some suction created).
4. Pull up on the top of the tool to remove the current dial. If not enough suction was created, please try again. Add or subtract moisture and soap as needed or reposition.
5. Using either mild soap and water or rubbing alcohol, clean the inside of the dial. Be sure to thoroughly dry the inside of the dial to remove any excess soap or alcohol.
6. Take the new dial and align the pattern correctly with the dial. **Note the 3 tabs and how it can only be aligned one way.**
7. Press the new dial down into place and you are finished.
